During your reservation period, there are deadlines you must meet to retain your Cap Allocation. Please ensure that you are aware of your project deadlines, so that you may request help, if needed, before the deadline passes. Failure to comply with applicable deadlines will result in **revocation of your Cap Allocation**.

To ensure your Cap Allocation reservation remains current, you must do one of the following actions before your Reservation End Date:

- 1. Report receipt of Authorization to Interconnect by sending a copy to us as soon as possible and no later than your applicable deadline; or
- 2. Secure an Extended Reservation period under Section 7(B) of the System of Assurance of Net Metering Eligibility.
 - Extended Reservation Period for a Fee, which offers an additional six months beyond the initial Reservation Period, must be requested **30 days prior to the end of the current Reservation Period** and requires an additional deposit.
 - Extended Reservation Period for Legal Challenges, which offers up to an additional six months beyond the initial Reservation Period if a governmental permit or approval for the Facility was subject to a pending legal challenge.
 - **Extended Reservation Period Pending Authorization to Interconnect**, which offers additional time until such notice of authorization to interconnect is received or denied.

Additional attestations and/or review are required to obtain an Extended Reservation Period Pending Authorization to Interconnect or an Extended Reservation Period for Legal Challenges.

You will be able to view your project and its details under **My Projects**. Changes to your facility must be made via the Quarterly Reporting form.
